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# Creative Art Sample Activities

## Weekly Projects

### Scarecrow Festival

Together, the group decides upon a theme for their display and using resources supplied create a display to be presented at the end of the week. The scarecrows can be people or animals and will be very imaginative and rustic!

### Time Capsule

Children can collaborate any ideas they may have to put in their time capsules, from this time in history. Include pictures, models, drawings and writing about the pandemic, Queens Jubilee, climate change etc. This will be buried at Fairthorne and left for future years to discover.

## Daily Projects

**Tie Dye** – create a range of socks and t shirts with varying print designs. Dyes can be made out of natural products, but we also have some ready made.

**Forest Faces** – have fun making faces on the trees using clay as a base and then decorating the faces and hair from scavenged items

**Kites** – make and fly and kite using recycled plastic bags and twigs you find on site

**Rainbow Wind Chimes** – will be made with different size and thickness branches, painted in bright colours and hung from a branch to blow in the wind.

**Bug Hotels** – these can be made using plastic bottles, toilet roll holders, tin cans, all sorts of recyclables. Fill the items with moss, leaves, twigs, grass etc. Decorate with signs and display in your gardens.

**Jewellery Making** – with special stones to create a choice of jewellery items to keep.
