Your accommodation

Ben's House

A purpose-built single-storey block within the old walled garden of the Manor House, accommodating up to 84 people across 3 wings. It includes 4-bed bunk rooms with sinks for students, shared bathroom facilities, twin ensuite rooms for leaders, a leaders' lounge, tea/coffee facilities, and wifi access.



Heald House

A 3-story, 88-bed accommodation with 2, 4 and 6 bunk bed rooms, shared bathrooms, sinks in each room, twin ensuite leaders' rooms, central meeting areas with seating, free wifi, and tea/coffee facilities for leaders.

Camping

Our pre-erected canvas tents have wooden floors and are located in 4 tent villages. Each village has its own communal marquee equipped with lighting, chairs, a fridge, and tea/coffee-making facilities. Toilet and shower facilities are located nearby


